All participants **must** complete the online self-learning course and assessment **before 1 September 2023** to be considered for the in-person component from 10 to 14 October 2023. Entrance into the programme is free, but in-person participants must fund their own flights, airport transfer and travel insurance.

Programme Overview

The programme consists of two parts. To be considered for the in-person component, participants **must** complete the online self-learning course and assessment.

1. Online Self-Learning Platform (August 2023)

Upon acceptance into the programme, you will receive your log-in details to the AYLP online self-learning platform.

You will learn about ASEAN & Cultural Intelligence, meet and discuss with your fellow young leaders and Common Purpose facilitators and start thinking about the three sub-themes.

To graduate and/or be considered for the in-person program, you will have to participate in the discussions and complete a final reflection.

2. In-Person @ Jakarta, Indonesia (10 to 14 October 2023)

Experience Jakarta—the heart of the ASEAN Secretariat & Chairmanship of ASEAN 2023—as we make full use of the city as a classroom.

Form idea groups and brainstorm together, interact directly with senior leaders and go on immersion visits around the city to learn about the subthemes!

The program will start at 2pm on 10 October and accommodation will be provided with check-out on 14 October.





FAQs

How will I know if I am selected for the in-person programme?

After completing the online programme and applying for the inperson session, we will evaluate your application. You will receive a email with the result of your application from Common Purpose by 1 September 2023.

What expenses are covered for the inperson programme?

Meals, transport and accommodation are provided from 10 to 14 October. However, you will have to fund your own travel insurance and transport (flights, airport transfer or land) to the programme venue on 10 October.
